

## Study Hall Guidelines

- All students who are in study hall for a particular hour need to stay in the room (except, of course, to use the restroom if necessary.)
- Students may read, study or do other silent work that they have brought from home. The study hall monitor can answer questions if students have them on work they have brought along but are not required to do so. "I don't know", or "You'll have to wait and ask your mom" are perfectly fine.
- Music with headphones that cannot be heard outside the headphones is permitted, but games and things that can visually distract others are not permitted.
- Students may have a water bottle in study hall, but no food please.
- Study hall mom may, at her discretion, allow 5-10 minutes of talking quietly together at the end of study hall as a "reward" for working diligently the rest of the time. No more than 10 minutes please.
